THIS CONTRACT for the personal services of musicians on the engagement described below, made this

day of

_19___7, Detween the undersigned Purchaser of Music (herein "Employer musicians.* (including leader)

The musicians are engaged severally on the terms and conditions on the face he presents that the musicians already designated have agreed to be bound by said terms and conditions. Each musician yet to be chosen, upon acceptance, shall be bound by said terms and conditions. Each musician may enforce this agreement. The musicians severally agree to render services under the undersigned leader.

4. WAGE AGREED UPON \$ 7500.00 + 60\$ \$15,000.00 (4200 seats, house scaled to approx. \$21,000.00) + \$750. for

This wage includes expenses agreed to be reimbursed by the employer in accordance with the attached schedule, or a schedule to be furnished the Employer on or before the date of engagement.

5. Employer will make payments up follows: \$3750.00 made payable to Magna Artists Corp. is required by Jan. 2. Balande to artist (Specify when payments are to be made) at intermission cash, certified check or money order

Upon request by the Federation or the local in whose jurisdiction the musicians shall perform hereunder, Employer either shall make advance payment hereunder or shall post an appropriate bond.

If the engagement is subject to contribution to the A.F.M. & E.P.W. Pension Welfare Fund, the leader will collect same from the Employer and pay it to the Fund; and the Employer and leader agree to be bound by the Trust Indenture dated October 2. 1959, as amended, relating to services rendered hereunder in the U. S., and by the Agreement and Declaration of Trust dated April 9, 1962, as amended, relating to services rendered hereunder in Canada.

6. The Employer shall at all times have complete supervision, direction and control over the services of musicians on this engagement and expressly reserves the right to control the manner, means and details of the performance of services by the musicians including the leader as well as the ends to be accomplished. If any musicians have not been chosen upon the signing of this contract, the leader shall, as agent for the Employer and under his instructions, hire such persons and any replacements as are required.

In accordance with the Constitution, By-laws, Rules and Regulations of the Federation, the parties will submit every claim, dispute, controversy or difference involving the musical services arising out of or connected with this contract and the engagement covered thereby for determination by the International Executive Board of the Federation or a similar board of an appropriate local thereof and such determination shall be conclusive, final and binding upon the parties.

Additional Terms and Conditions

The leader shall, as agent of the Employer, enforce disciplinary measures for just cause, and carry out instructions as to selections and manner of performance. The agreement of the musicians to perform is subject to proven detention by sickness, accidents, riots, strikes, epidemics, acts of God, or any other legitimate conditions beyond their control. On behalf of the Employer the leader will distribute the amount received from the Employer to the musicians, including himself as indicated on the opposite side of this contract, or in place thereof on separate memorandum supplied to the Employer at or before the commencement of the employment hereunder and take and turn over to the Employer receipts therefor from each musician, including himself. The amount paid to the leader includes the cost of transportation, which will be reported by the leader to the Employer.

All employees covered by this agreement must be members in good standing of the Federation. However, if the employment provided for hereunder is subject to the Labor-Management Relations Act, 1947, all employees who are members of the Federation when their employment commences hereunder shall be continued in such employment only so long as they continue such membership in good standing. All other employees covered by this agreement, on or before the thirtieth day following the commencement of their employment, or the effective date of this agreement, whichever is later, shall become and continue to be members in good standing of the Federation. The provisions of this paragraph shall not become effective unless and until permitted by applicable law.

To the extent permitted by applicable law, nothing in this contract shall ever be construed so as to interfere with any duty owing by any musician performing hereunder to the Federation pursuant to its Constitution, By-laws, Rules, Regulations and Orders.

Additional Terms and Conditions (continued)

To the extent permitted by applicable law, any musicians on this engagement are free to cease service hereunder by reason of any strike, ban, unfair list order or requirement of the Federation or of any Federation local approved or sanctioned by the Federation, and shall be free to accept and engage in other employment of the same or similar character or otherwise, without any restraint, hindrance, penalty, obligation or liability whatever, any other provisions of this contract to the contrary notwithstanding.

Representatives of the Federation local in whose jurisdiction the musicians shall perform hereunder shall have access to the place of performance (except to private residences) for the purpose of conferring with the musicians.

No performance on the engagement shall be recorded, reproduced or transmitted from the place of performance, in any manner or by any means whatsoever, in the absence of a specific written agreement with the Federation relating to and permitting such recording, reproduction or transmission.

The Employer represents that there does not exist against him, in favor of any member of the Federation, any claim of any kind arising out of musical services rendered for such Employer. No musician will be required to perform any provisions of this contract or to render any services for said Employer as long as any such claim is unsatisfied or unpaid, in whole or in part. If the Employer breaches this agreement, he shall pay the musicians in addition to damages, 6% interest thereof plus a reasonable attorney's fee.

To the extent permitted by applicable law, all of the Constitution, By-laws, Rules and Regulations of the Federation and of any local thereof applicable to this engagement (not in conflict with those of the Federation) will be adhered to and the parties acknowledge that they are and each has the obligation to be, fully acquainted the employer or by any of the employees.

RIDER TO CONTRACT DATED ///9/7/ BETWEEN LEONARD COHEN, PRODUCTIONS, INC. FSO LEONARD COHEN (HEREINAFTER FEDERATION (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "OPERATOR")

OF STUDENTS

THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS SHALL BE DEEMED INCORPORATED IN AND MADE PART OF THE ANNEXED AGREEMENT:

- A: One Hammond B 3 Organ in proper working condition with two Leslie tone cabinets is to be provided by the Operator. Organ must also have Leslie speed control switch and proper bench.
- B: Operator is to supply one grand or baby grand piano with bench. Piano must be tuned to Standard 440 Pitch on day of concert.
- C: Operator is to supply a sound mixing platform a minimum of eight (8) feet wide by eight (8) deep and four (4) feet high and it must be located half way back in the hall, right of house center. There must be (3) three chairs on the platform. In houses with permancent seating, provisions must be made to locate sound mixing console and equipment in above position.
- D: Operator shall provide at his softe cost and expense, beside items listed above, two super troupers with operators. Said troupers to have assortment of color gels. There must also be headset communication between backstage and said operators. Said operators to be under the direction of Artist's stage manager.
- E: Operator agrees to furnish at his sole cost and expense at least four (4) stage hands who will help bring in the equipment and take out the equipment that Artist will furnish for audio amplification.
- F: Operator must insure that the sound company, lighting and all stage personnel be completely set up and at Artist's disposal for sound and technical check at least three hours prior to the opening of the doors to the public.
- NOTE: The above does not mean that all necessary equipment be brought in three hours prior. It means simply to please have the above ready in working condition three hours prior.
- G: Facility must have three adequate dressing rooms with locks and private bathroom facilities. Operator must also provide and insure proper backstage and dressing room security. No one to be allowed backstage either prior, during or after performance without Artist's (and/or representative's) approval.

- H: It is understood and agreed that there are no opening acts on this program!!
- I: Artist to receive 100% Top Billing in all advertising.
- J. Artist shall receive twenty (20) complimentary tickets for engagement hereunder.
- K. Operator shall have available in Artist's dressing room facility to make hot tea (electric hot plate) plus tea bags, honey, lemons, cups and saucers and water.
